

Many customers enjoy the convenience of automatic bank draft to pay their utility bill. This method of payment allows you to have your payment transferred each month directly from a bank account. The information below will help you understand more about the service and how you can sign up.

- With Bank drafting, youwill receive your regular utility bill each month. Printed on the bill will be the message "Bank Draft".
- On your due date, the payment will automatically be deducted from your bank account. A minimum of 7 days notice prior to your due date is required to terminate the service
- You can apply for this service simply by completing this authorization form and returning it with either a voided check or check image. There is a maximum set up period of 4 weeks to establish the service with your bank
- It is important to remember that inadequate funds in your bank account to cover the payment will be handled like a returned check. Both your bank and the utility will assess an appropriate service charge.
