

The City of Carmel Utilities is proud to offer its customers the Carmel Citizens Utility Academy, providing insight to the public on the responsibilities and operations of Water, Wastewater, Trash & Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste Disposal services.

The Carmel Citizens Utility Academy is a seven-week program. The session presenters are staff members of Carmel Utilities and Republic Services who provide instruction and information concerning a particular area of their profession. Tours of Utility and recycling facilities are a key part of the program.

Academy Requirements for participants include:

- Be at least 18 years old
- A resident of the City of Carmel
- Commit to attend 7 weekly training sessions lasting 2+ hours during a weekday morning (usually Tuesdays)
- Sign any required waivers or agreements

Class size is limited to 12 people and applications will be reviewed on a first come first served basis.
