## CARMEL HHW

### WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO DISPOSE OF HHW PROPERLY?

- Substances poured into household drains and toilets go into the sewage treatment process, eventually impacting fish, wildlife and the environment
- HHW poured into the soil, streets or into storm water drains are carried to creeks, causing harm to waterways and wildlife
- Throwing hazardous waste into the trash can contaminate entire loads of garbage and threaten sanitation workers, who can be injured by acids, fires and explosions

### HOW TO REDUCE HHW

- Use It Up. Use up all products before purchasing more. Most products do not expire.
- Simplify. Use multi-purpose cleaners rather than having a full collection of specialized products.
- Purchase less. Buy only the amount needed, even if a larger container offers a price discount.

## HOW TO BRING MATERIALS TO THE CARMEL COLLECTION SITE

- Do not mix materials
- Bring all materials in the original container if possible
- If not in original labeled container, please label container used
- Tighten lids on all containers
- If containers are leaking, pack separately or in large containers

## MEDICAL SHARPS COLLECTION

Carmel Household Hazardous Waste collects medical sharps (needles) but must be in a medical sharp 8 quart container or less. Please note medical sharps containers are NOT available at the Carmel HHW site.

- Septic Tank Degreaser
- Wood Preservatives
- Wood Stripper

### HOUSEHOLD CARE

- Aerosol Cans
- Ammonia
- Bleach
- Drain Cleaners
- Fire Extinguishers
- Floor Cleaner
- Moth Balls
- Oven Cleaner
- Silver/Copper Polish

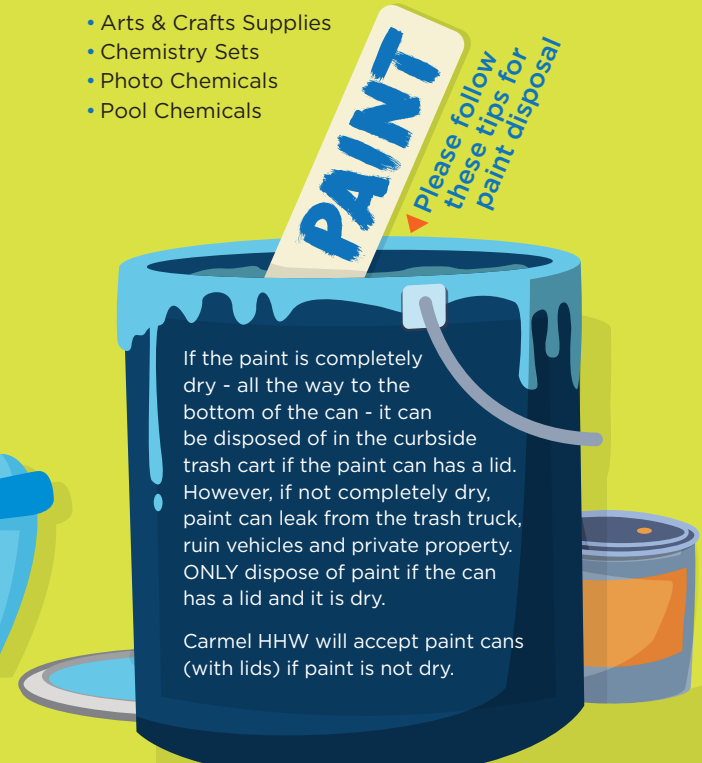
- Herbicides
- Fertilizer

### MOTOR & VEHICLE CARE (Container size must be smaller than 2.5 gallons):

- Antifreeze (limit is 4 gallons/year)
- Brake Fluid
- Gasoline (Must be in a proper fuel container; 5 gallon container or less)
- Motor Oil (limit is 15 gallons/year)
- Rust Preventative

### MERCURY PRODUCTS

- Iodine
- Mercury Thermometers
- Mercury Thermostats



If the paint is completely dry - all the way to the bottom of the can - it can be disposed of in the curbside trash cart if the paint can has a lid. However, if not completely dry, paint can leak from the trash truck, ruin vehicles and private property. ONLY dispose of paint if the can has a lid and it is dry.

Carmel HHW will accept paint cans (with lids) if paint is not dry.
